

## Tips for Submitting Abstracts

## All abstract submissions must:

- Be submitted by the deadline. Late submissions will not be considered.
- Be 400 words or less
- Not be review articles or single case reports
- Contain the following 5 sections:
  - a. background/rationale,
  - b. objective(s)
  - c. method(s)
  - d. results\*
  - e. conclusions/discussion\*
    - \*For Trainee Research, results and conclusions are not required for initial abstract submission, but are required by the time of presentation at the conference, and at the time of submission for Top Ten consideration
- Include references and disclosure of industry sponsored research
- List all author(s) (including name, credentials, title, facility, and location)

Authors will select one of two research categories during the submission process:

- <u>Clinical/Translational Research</u> projects are designed to investigate the safety and/or effectiveness of a medication, treatment strategy, or medication-containing device in humans.
- <u>Practice Management Research</u> projects are designed to improve medication safety, establish best practices, and/or explore the role of the hematology/oncology pharmacy personnel in patient care through the enhancement of pharmacy resources.

Selected Completed and Late-Breaking Research abstracts will be published in the <u>Journal of Hematology/Oncology Pharmacy</u> (JHOP), HOPA's official peer-reviewed forum for oncology pharmacy practice.
