





Allows participants to gain a greater understanding of mutual areas of interest



- Application for participation indicates agreement to abide by these policies and any other rules governing activities on the council.

Violations of stated or implied policies will be reported to HOPA and may result in forfeiture of council participation, at the sole discretion of HOPA
